## Meeting agenda and minutes:

- 3. Vasile asked Steve to request the third quarter statement from the Paul Corp.
- 4. On-going homeowner complaints (items still not repaired or replaced)
- 5. Liability regarding the Pool and the Property Manager not being onsite on Sundays
- 6. Compliance issues
- 7. Issues with the Sprinkler System
- 8. Status of Service Providers' Warranties and the Need for them to carry over to the HOA
- 9. Drainage Issues

- 10. Concrete and asphalt issues
- 11. Security Issues
- 12. Need for Files, from Pauls Corp., on homeowners
